



Pearce Recycling provides collection, bulking and recycling from our centrally located St Albans Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) site for mixed recyclables, cardboard, glass and paper.

Pearce Recycling also provide a collection service and skip provision for local cardboard and paper banks, as well as dedicated bulking bays for glass and paper storage. We manage all grades for and on behalf of our local borough.

Pearce Recycling work in partnership with St Albans City and District Council to achieve the best possible price for all grades of materials collected or delivered by the contracted service provider. These grades are processed at our new MRF in St Albans.

- We provide the Council with a separation and reprocessing service for mixed recyclables from the kerbside. Our MRF reprocesses and segregates mixed recyclables such as alloy, steel cans, mixed coloured glass, plastic bottles and packaging waste.
- The Council contractors deliver in the above grades and we work with the contract to try and achieve a recycling target of 60% per annum.
- We supply specialised skips for cardboard storage and transport as well as dedicated collection service for all local paper banks.

Materials are delivered to dedicate holding bays, prior to sortation and processing. We gather all Data on materials and use our bespoke software package to provide monthly Management Reports.

We also provide full onsite training to all driving staff prior to first delivery and provide site instructions to all new delivery staff from the Council.

St Albans City and District Council vehicles operate out of the Ronsons Way, St Albans site but use our facility as their own MRF.

They provide the local residents with a bespoke collection service for general waste disposal and kerbside collected recycling materials.

Our Customer Service Department work closely with Council staff to make sure that the services provided by us work faultlessly and all information provided is accurate and up to standard.

Our mill sales department provide baled materials to mills throughout the UK and abroad. They have total control of all purchased materials, their final destinations and audit all destinations regularly.
