



Pearce Recycling, St Albans provides two types of MRF tipping facility for Welwyn and Hatfield Borough Council.



- Storage and bulking of news and pams paper grade material collected from the kerbside in the Welwyn and Hatfield.
- Storage and re-processing with automatic segregation of mixed cans and glass through our new dedicated MRF sorting plant at our St Albans re processing site.

Pearce Recycling has the responsibility of bulking and transporting segregated materials to sites for and on behalf of Welwyn and Hatfield Council. Most of these sites are within easy reach of our local area.

We receive Local Authority vehicles at the site on a daily basis and all crews report to our Reception Area at our Main Entrance. The Weighbridge Team checks all relevant paperwork and place the weight data on our bespoke software package. Vehicles are then directed to the appropriate section of the site to unload their materials.

Our Yard Staff check the contents of the load and let the driving team return to the Weighbridge to finish the weighing process.

All data is stored until the end of the month and an electronic report provided to our Council contact.

Welwyn and Hatfield Borough Council operate a fleet of collection vehicles from the Tewin Road, Welwyn Garden City transport base.

They provide local residents with a waste collection and recycling service throughout their Borough.

We work in close partnership with the client to ensure that the contract runs smoothly and all relevant reports and legislation requirements are met.

We provide a full audit trail for all materials re-processed via our dedicated Mill Sales Department. We currently accept approximately 4000 tonnes of cans and glass per year. www.welhat.gov.uk
